## Introduction to Play Work

Whether you work in a mainstream or in a special needs setting this introduction to play work course will challenge and inspire you, helping your staff to create a high quality play setting.

This course includes an introduction to play theories, creating a child centred environment and enhances the skills needed to facilitate better quality childcare.

## An Introduction to Child Protection (mix & match)

This is a vital piece of training for everyone involved in the care of children. Arm yourself with the knowledge you need to ensure the safety and well being of the children and young people who attend your setting and gain the basic skills needed to deal with a child disclosing information to you.

## **An Introduction to Behaviour Management** (mix & match)

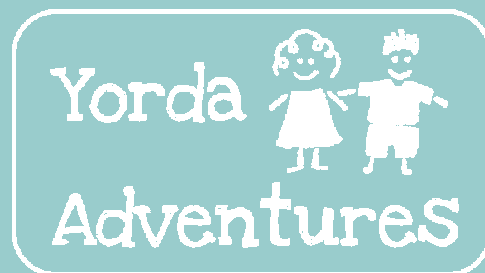
