



Adventure Playground

For many years we have been seeking to build a specialist play space within the borough of Kingston upon Thames to enhance the provision we are able to offer the children & young people who attend our projects, in particular the working-parent childcare we provide in partnership with Dysart School.

We have been fortunate over the last three years to use Southwood District Scout Hut on the Tolworth Sunray Estate. We are now designing an adventure playground to go on this land, thanks to support from the District scout committee and all those at 6th Tolworth.

We are working with Cave Cooperative who specialise in sustainable design, to create a play environment that is accessible to children of all abilities and are looking at incorporating high climbing areas with slides, nest swings and possibly even a zip-line with quieter areas and areas of sensory interest. The play space will be primarily made from natural, reclaimed materials.

Over the coming year we will be keeping you up to date with our progress, both through the website and mailings. This will be a massive fundraising task, but we are really excited about it!
